

Malachi 06 “Is It Discipline Or Is It Judgment?”

Malachi 3:1-5; Leviticus 26:14-39

And so, unbelievers suffer from self-inflicted pain as a result of their free will choices within their souls which begin with a series of mental attitude motivated sins.

Individual divine discipline is reserved for God’s Royal Family and His judgment is designated for those outside the family.

Judgment by pain on earth is the function of God’s grace in crisis evangelism and His grace extended before judgment, is the function of His normal evangelism.

But God in His unparalleled grace, gives all unbelievers another free chance to choose His costly (to Him) salvation.

Crisis evangelism is the judgment of God in bringing an unbeliever back to temporary objective reality at the end of his human resources and that gives him a sobering objective opportunity to consider Jesus Christ.

Man’s free choice to function apart from virtue, integrity or law-abiding restraint is self-destructive and when man is negative toward authority and the responsibility developed from it, he becomes degenerate through either organized or disorganized evil.

The answer to divine discipline is found in God’s desire to perpetuate a nation through effective evangelism.
