

Malachi 10 “Time For A Change? Not With God” Malachi 3:4-6

People change and things change BUT God never changes Who He is; He NEVER says: “That was then but this is now, so I can no longer honor My Word.”

We talked about the decisive choices on the part of the spiritual leadership of Judah and the people in each instance which led to the inevitable course of God’s loving, gracious discipline in 5 cycles; with the 5th being the ultimate takeover and enslavement of the nation.
