

“To Their Own Master, Servants Stand or Fall” Matthew 7:1-5

Divine discipline is for believers only; Hebrews 12:6 “The Lord disciplines the one He loves and He chastens everyone He accepts as His son.”

And so, divine discipline is a family matter based on love and it does not ever include the loss of salvation.

There are two schools of learning but only in the University of Biblical Truth as opposed to the School of Hard Knocks does our suffering have significance in the fulfillment of the experiential plan of God.

And by the grace of God, being a loser in the spiritual life doesn't imply loss of salvation, just the loss of greater blessings deposited in each Church Age believer's escrow account for both time and eternity.

Contradictions cannot exist in the plan of God for His Church and because God is perfect; His plan is perfect and the problem therefore, is that we are imperfect.

Spirituality is just another term for the filling of the Holy Spirit so, when we're in a state of sin performing human good or evil, we are not spiritual because we're outside of our protective palace in a place where our sinful nature controls our soul.

When we're experiencing abiding fellowship with God; we are spiritual in the sense that the Holy Spirit is influencing and leading us so, when we live in God's palace, we're executing His plan and gaining momentum from processing His Word.

Only one ministry of the Holy Spirit is temporary: the filling of the Holy Spirit which is synonymous with residence in the experiential plan of God.

All the sins of human history were imputed to Jesus Christ on the Cross and judged by the justice of God the Father and our Lord's work provides two things for us: our salvation and our post-salvation restored fellowship with God.

Apart from God's recovery technique, we would have been carnal the first time we sinned after our salvation and there would have been no experiential plan of God for our lives; no spirituality and no protocol to follow.

A misunderstanding of spirituality and carnality is the reason that many people do not advance to spiritual maturity.

The most miserable people on earth are those who are always trying to micro-manage someone else's life.

We must become aware of the fact of the dangers of this particular sin of critically evaluating others and learn to mind our own business.

The people who are inclined to mind their own business are those who have cleared the log jams from their own lives.

Self-righteousness is a terrible enemy and it's one of those things that makes the unbeliever run away in disgust.
