

“Let Freedom Ring” John 8:36 Romans 13:1-7

Human freedom grants the citizens of a nation the right to publicly express themselves and live in harmony with one another without fear of reprisal for enjoying the equal treatment of all.

God’s structural plan is unique in that it remains perfect despite the inclusion of imperfect man who cannot obstruct Operation Grace, since its execution depends entirely upon the work of the Trinity in each phase of the Plan.

And why do we just have to believe to be saved? Because there’s nothing we can add to the finished work of Jesus Christ; our faith is non-meritorious, meaning all the merit or credit is in Him, the Object of our faith.

The Fall of man presents the fact of his free will choice because the only way Adam could have fallen was to choose to live his life independently of God.

So, the issue in the human race remains: will the free will of man act in conjunction with the sovereign will of God or act independently of it?

When pride gets into the mind, it’s no longer: “What are the facts or what does the Bible say?” because it becomes all about me and who I am and what I want and need that counts!

Authority without freedom is tyranny and freedom without authority is anarchy and under God’s established laws, freedom and authority are perfectly joined so we cannot have one without the other; freedom without the authority of biblical truth is lawlessness and authority without the freedom of the Royal priesthood being exercised is legalism.

The greatness of a nation can only be measured by the virtue of its freedom and the integrity of its authority.

And because we as believers in Jesus Christ all begin our Christian lives with the freedom of equal privilege and equal opportunity, there is no equality in Heaven.

Just as human freedom is the heritage of physical birth, spiritual freedom is the heritage of the new birth or our regeneration.

Spiritual freedom cannot be guarded by our Constitution; it can only be guarded by our own positive free will response to biblical truth and by our momentum inside our very own palace, the experiential plan of God.

When we look into the mirror of the Word of God, it’s not our reflection we see; the mirror of the Word produces the reflection of Jesus Christ as the Shekinah Glory of God.

An adult must be free to make his own successes or mistakes and so, he must take the responsibility for all his decisions.

The Word of God is called the law of liberty because it defines our freedom to glorify God through the application of biblical truth.

If we’re going to serve God, we must have freedom from our sinful natures, even though our sinful natures are still within us.

As a matter of fact, all freedom is designed so that without hindrance or coercion, mankind might hear the Gospel, respond with faith in Christ and advance to spiritual maturity by the intake of biblical truth.

All spiritual blessing, from salvation to greater-grace status and dying grace beyond, is based on the individual freedom that makes it possible for a person to hear the Gospel, respond by faith in Christ and advance to spiritual maturity.
